


Fun Facts

- Hershey Company produces ~20 million kisses each day, using 133 sq. miles of aluminum wrapping—most of which ends up in the landfill not recycle bin = 12,785 rooms the size of this hall!
- Mount Rumpke, the highest point in Ohio
 (1000+ ft), is literally a mountain of trash.
- The U.S. recycles ~28% of its waste, which is doubled from that of a decade ago.
- The U.S. generates ~230 million tons of trash = 4.6 lbs. per person per day.
- Recycling one can saves enough energy to run a TV for three hours = half a gallon of gas.
- Recycling a single run of the Sunday New York Times would save 75,000 trees.



What You Can Do

- o Reduce needless consumption and the generation of waste.
- o Reuse any item that can be, or donate it to charity.
- o Recycle as much as you can.
- Buy products in concentrate, bulk and in refillable containers. They reduce packaging waste and can save money!
