To help guide you through this year's festival, we've compiled some basic facts and information for your reference.

Festival Hall Access

Credentialed media is allowed access to the Festival Hall 15 minutes before ticketholders. Access times are as follows:

- Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings: 5:15 p.m.-10:00 p.m.
- Saturday afternoon: 11:45 a.m.-4:00 p.m.

Media Center

Credentialed media have access to a space on the lower level of the Convention Center, around the corner from Will Call. The Media Center offers water, coffee and Internet access to conduct business. Equipment storage is available (leave items at your own risk), but the room will be locked each night at 10:00 p.m. Room hours:

- Friday, October 7: 3:00 pm 10:00 pm
- Saturday, October 8: 9:45 am 10:00 pm






Around the Festival Hall

- Brewers Studio Pavilion Featured Panel: Why Independence Matters: On Thursday, October 6 at 8:30 pm MT, Bob Pease, Brewers Association; Rob Tod, Allagash Brewing Company; Sam Calagione, Dogfish Head Craft Brewery; Greg Koch, Stone Brewing Company and Christine Perich, New Belgium Brewing Company will come together to discuss the origins of beer in America, its current landscape and what the future holds. The panel will take place in the Brewers Studio Pavilion inside the Festival Hall. If you are credentialed for the Thursday GABF session, we'd strongly urge you to please come by.
- Golden Ticket Tour: During each evening session, two rock-star craft brewers will pluck a lucky attendee and their friends from the queue in Hall A for a special, private tasting tour of GABF before the festival doors open.
