To help guide you through this year's festival, we've compiled some basic facts and information for your reference.

Festival Hall Access

Credentialed media is allowed access to the Festival Hall 15 minutes before ticketholders. Access times are as follows:

- Thursday, October 5 Saturday, October 7: 5:15 p.m.-10:00 p.m. •
- Saturday, October 7: 11:45 a.m.-4:00 p.m.

Media Center

Credentialed media have access to a space on the lower level of the Convention Center, around the corner from Will Call. The media center offers water, coffee and Internet access to conduct business. Equipment storage is available during the sessions, but the room will be locked each night at 10:00 pm. No overnight storage of equipment will be allowed. Room hours:
